Our Asks

- We will be focused on appropriations- for both STAR Act and NCI/NIH funding
- We will have one other ask that is to be determined
- You will have supportive materials to review
- Plenty of time to practice with your group



Digital Advocacy

- If you cannot attend in person- this is your chance to activate your networks from home
- Please prep your networks that you are coming to DC
- Biggest push will be when we are on the Hill
- We will send you sample tweets, hashtags and Facebook posts
- Take photos when getting on plane, when you arrive etc- tell the story in photos/digitally



Get Your Gold Gear

- Important to have a visual presence on the Hill.
- We encourage you to wear gold ties, scarves, ribbons etc to represent our cause.
- Please stay away from the use of yellow gold as that can be confused easily with the yellow used for the military ribbon by the Hill
- Please stay away from wearing organization specific gear as we are trying to show our unified voice on the Hill
