The Hope Portal is:

- A comprehensive database of childhood cancer support service organizations (<u>www.hope-portal.org</u>)
- Connects patients, survivors, and their families to resources quickly
- A collaborative success model that demonstrates the power of a unified community











Hope Portal By The Numbers

- 381 organizations listed
- 44 states represented
- 34,982 visitors to the site in last year
- 10,222 outbound clicks to organizations last year



Hope Portal Leadership Opportunity

State Liaisons Time Commitment

- Twice a year: Reach out to treatment center staff about Hope Portal
 - CAC2 will follow up with print materials
- Twice a year: Reach out to other childhood cancer charities in your state and invite them to join the Hope Portal. There is no cost to join the Hope Portal and they don't have to be a CAC2 member.
 - CAC2's Hope Portal vetting team will help them get set up

Who Will This Benefit?


- Childhood and adolescent cancer survivors and their caregivers

Value of the Program to CAC2

What we have accomplished



How Will It Work?

- Our goal is that the CAC2 Connection would exist on the CAC2 Survivorship page.
- This program consists of a 'navigator' being available via email to assist individuals looking for survivorship resources, creating that personalized approach.
- A survivor or caregiver, or a nonprofit organization or medical professional serving this population, would submit a question regarding a survivorship concern(s), (i.e. camps or outdoor adventures, support groups, college scholarships for survivors, etc.).
- Then, within a defined period of time, the trained navigator would search our database to find organizations that fit their specific need or concern.
