How do I register?

[Registration](#) is available online. Please note that only CAC2 members in good standing are permitted to attend the Members' Business Meeting on Thursday. Registration closes on June 14, 2022.

Can I bring a guest?

Of course. Please invite anyone you care to bring who may be interested in the Summit program. Make sure you register each guest separately so we can keep accurate track of attendees.

Who should attend?

All stakeholders in the childhood and AYA community are invited to attend the Summit. Only CAC2 members in good standing are permitted to attend and participate in the Business Meeting on Thursday. The Summit is designed for adults. Please reflect on your child's age and interests when considering their attendance.

What is the registration fee for the Annual Summit?

Registration is complimentary for all CAC2 Members. This includes all childhood cancer and supporting organization members and associate members, individual members, and student members.

If you do not belong to CAC2 please note the registration fees below. You will be sent an invoice following your registration.

Registration fee structure:

- Non-affiliated Individual: \$50
- Representative from a Non-Profit Foundation: \$100
- Industry Partner Representative: \$200

Non-members who join CAC2 before September 1, 2022 will have their Annual Summit registration fee applied to their membership dues.

Are meals provided during the Summit?
