How do I register for the CAC2 Summit?

We require registration for the CAC2 Annual Summit so we can plan for meals and other activities. Click this link to [register now](#) through Whova.

What is the cost to register?

Registration is complimentary for all CAC2 Members. This includes all childhood cancer organization members, individual members, associate members, student members and supporting organization members. For non-members, a registration fee does apply. You will be sent an invoice following your registration. Registration for non-members will open sometime in March.

Can anyone attend the Summit?

Yes, anyone is invited to attend the Summit, with the exception of the Annual Meeting on Tuesday. Only CAC2 members in good standing are permitted to attend the Business Meeting on Tuesday.

Should children attend the Summit?

The Summit is an adult meeting, containing presentations and panels from subject-matter experts on a variety of topics related to research, treatment, advocacy, family support, and survivorship. Most children would not be interested in attending.

Will there be a virtual attendance option?

The Summit is an in-person event. Therefore, a virtual viewing option will not be available.



Are meals included at the Summit?

We provide breakfast and lunch on both Monday and Tuesday. There is also a reception on Monday evening with beverages and light refreshments. Please indicate any dietary restrictions you may have when you register. As we get closer to the event, you will have the opportunity to share your dine around location preferences. You are responsible for your paying your meal at the dine-around.
